This show is conducted by the **Northeast Indiana Dairy Show, Inc.**; in cooperation with the various breed associations and the Noble County Community Fair. President, Greg Resler; Vice President, T J Franks; Secretary, Janeie Meyer; Treasurer, Brian Stump.

RULES:

1. Exhibitors may bring animals on June 24th, after 8:00 AM.
2. State Health Rules will prevail. **Ear tag #'s must be recorded on the NEIDS entry form.**
3. Entries can be made on the day of the show until **7:00 AM.**
4. All animals must be registered and papers shown upon request.
5. All animals must be entered in the name of the bonafide owner(s).
6. The management will not be responsible in any way for injury, loss or theft of any article or animals.
7. **Entry Fees:** Pre-entry fee - \$8.00 per head; June 24th or 25th entry fee - \$10.00 per head. Noble County 4-H Dairy Members - \$4.00 per head.
8. **PREMIUM MONEY: (MUST BE PICKED UP DAY OF SHOW, OR WILL BE FORFEITED)**
 - A) **JR FEMALE CLASSES:** 1st - \$10.00; 2nd - \$8.00; 3rd - \$6.00; 4th - \$4.00; 5th - \$2.00
 - B) **MILKING CLASSES (Classes 9 through 15):** 1st - \$20.00; 2nd - \$18.00; 3rd - \$15.00; 4th - \$12.00; 5th - \$10.00
 - C) **GROUP CLASSES:** 1st - \$3.00; 2nd - \$2.00; 3rd - \$1.00
 - D) A minimum of **5 animals per breed** must be shown to consider having a Championship class.
9. **SPECIAL AWARDS:** Banners, or cash equivalent (winners' choice), will be presented to the **Champion in each breed**, if 5 or more head per breed are exhibited. Cash award (\$20) for the **Premier Breeder** in each breed will be presented. **Premier Exhibitor** cash award (\$20) for each breed will be presented. (Must be 2 or more breeders per breed.)
Supreme Champion: Banner and \$50 cash premium will be awarded.
10. **Milking facilities are available and exhibitors are invited to use them. Cows on antibiotics cannot be milked into the bulk tank.**
11. **NOTE:** All cattle exhibited on Saturday **MUST BE REMOVED AFTER THE SHOW.**
